- **CSCC General Education Requirements:** Students should choose the General Education courses for the AA degree in consultation with their academic and faculty advisors.
- ***Intermediate Composition and Historical Study:** For the Intermediate Composition requirement, students may choose any course from ENGL 2367, 2567, 2667, or 2767. For the Historical Study requirement, two courses are required for the AA degree, one must be chosen from HIST 1151, 1152, 2223, or 2224. The second Historical Study course may be any course chosen from the list on the AA plan of study.
- **CSCC Degree Plan:** This Sample Graduation Plan was created using the general plan of study for the Columbus State Associate of Arts/Science degree. Students who are following a specific Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major at Columbus State may utilize this plan for the purposes of transfer and degree planning, but should note that additional course work may be necessary to complete the Columbus State Associate of Arts/Science Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major beyond what is required for the Bachelor of Mortuary Science degree at the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science. Additional course work completed as part of Columbus State's Bachelor's Degree Transfer Major may be applied as electives or where appropriate, course work toward the major/minor at the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science.
- ****MKTG 1230:** Students will need to speak with their Arts and Sciences Academic Advisor at Columbus State to have MKTG 1230 accepted as an elective toward the AA degree.
- **Notes about the BMS degree at CCMS:** Students will complete their AA degree here and then continue on at CCMS. Students wishing to earn only the Associate of Applied Science in Mortuary Science (AAS) degree will continue for three semesters. Those seeking the bachelor's degree (BMS) must attend one additional term for a total of four semesters. Plan for completion of the degree continues on Page 2 of this document.
